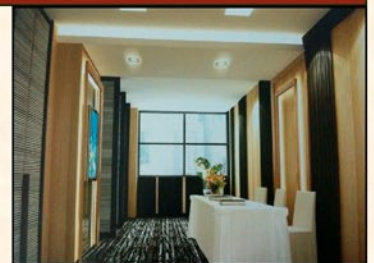
BEKKU Japanese Restaurant
